White: Facts and information, known or required

Red: Intuition, feelings

Black: Risk assessment, disadvantages, what can go wrong?

Yellow: Optimism, benefits and advantages

Green: Creativity, explores possibilities, alternatives and ways forward

Blue: Managing the process
